Why Emergency MRE Kit?

In majority of conflicts the most acute threat, with the highest number of civilian casualties, is typically within the first six weeks following the cessation of active hostilities

Emergency MRE is needed not only during or immediately after a conflict, but in response to threat that may be caused due to natural disasters which may uncover or move mines, and accidents such as explosion of arms depots.

Aim of Emergency MRE Kit

Designed to take a project manager step-by-step to develop and implement an emergency MRE campaign with first six weeks of an emergency.

Contents of Emergency MRE Kit

A Handbook:

- Assess and understand the threat
- Plan response
- Develop emergency MRE messages
- Identify communication channels
- Train teams (if needed)
- Implement and assess progress

A Resource Kit:

- Examples of printed materials
- Production elements
- Sample radio messages/spots for broadcasts
- Other tools and forms
