

## JMU Senior Managers Course – History and Participation Data

Prepared for the MASG meeting, October 15, 2020

- *Mine Action Management Training Study*, Bill van Ree and Mike McAlpine, March 1999 (UNDP & UNMAS, US & UK government support) – served as the starting point for course planning
- *Final report of the Evaluation of UNDP Mine Action Senior and Middle Management Training Courses*, February 2007 (Charles Downs, evaluation team leader) – evaluated senior and middle managers' courses from 2000-2006.
- JMU/CISR has conducted ongoing evaluation of its courses, with surveys sent out to national program directors, advisors and past participants periodically (2009, 2012, 2014, 2015 and 2019/20)
- 2000-2007 – 11 Senior Managers' Courses implemented (5 at JMU and 6 through Cranfield University) with UNDP funding/guidance. Over 40 Middle Management Courses by 2006.
- Three ERW Training Courses conducted by NCDR in Jordan with JMU/CISR providing the core management instruction and planning support (2009, 2010, 2011). Sponsored by US DOS
- 2010-2019 – JMU/CISR conducted 6 Senior Managers' Courses (SMCs) on the JMU campus and 4 regional SMCs (2 in Tajikistan, 2014 & 2018; 1 in Vietnam, 2015, and 1 in Croatia, 2017). All of these were funded by the US DOS PM/WRA.
- The following data on course participation is based on the 15 courses JMU/CISR conducted from 2004-2019 and the 3 ERWTCs conducted in Jordan 2009-2011
