Strategic Objectives & Expected Results

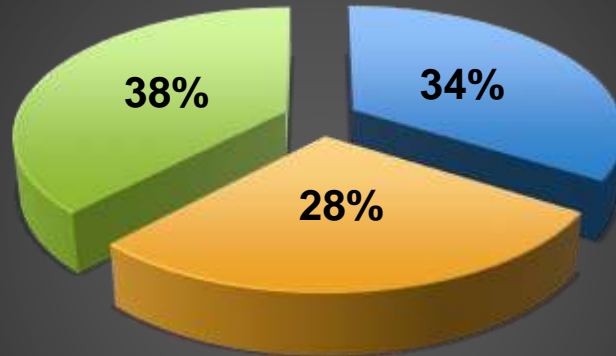
1. Affected communities enabled: RR teams ready for immediate intervention anywhere in Lebanon

CHALLENGES

- ❑ The Syrian Crisis: new DAs in the north eastern borders are affecting the Syrian refugees.
- ❑ Insufficient funds (decrease number of teams)
- ❑ New discovered areas contaminated specially with CM



ACTIONS

- Unified MA Program to manage the 5 pillars
- Countries coalition forum with the support of the Norwegian embassy in Beirut
- Intensive meetings with donors to enhance cooperation
- The contribution of GoL for CCM (2019- 2023)
- Increase the role of private sector
- Continuous update of the NMAS

Actions

- Use new technologies in MA
- Technical working group (LMAC, ER, NGOs) to benefit from the experiences and expertise during the demining ops in Lebanon
- Preparation to extend the strategy
- Process to sign Ottawa treaty
