## Principles

- Protect Children's Rights
- Impartiality and Neutrality
- Sustainability

## Comprehensive Approach

- Apply programming expertise
- Support global political process
- Generate evidence

Address all **six** grave violations:  
Killing and maiming of children;  
Recruitment or use of children as soldiers;  
Sexual violence against children;  
Abduction of children; Attacks against  
schools or hospitals; Denial of  
humanitarian access for children

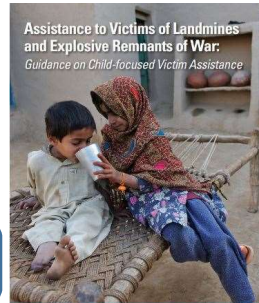

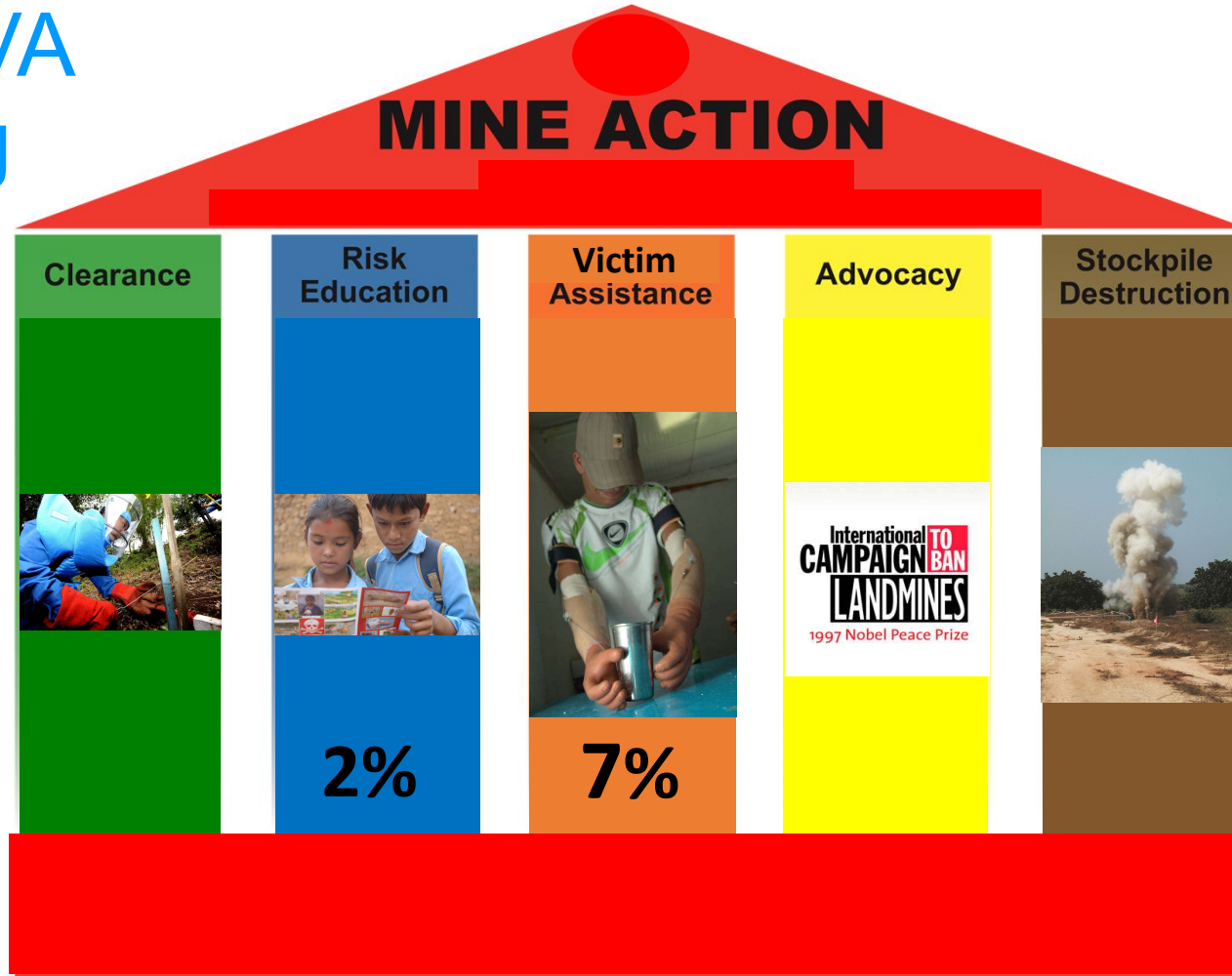
