The Global CWD Repository

The Global CWD Repository: a new repository in the JMU Scholarly Commons to house documentation related to the HMA/CWD field of practice

- **JMU Scholarly Commons**: an online library resource for sharing scholarship and research
- **CISR's *Journal of Conventional Weapons Destruction*** is housed in the JMU Scholarly Commons
