The ITF shall work with national authorities and in partnership with donors, NGOs, the private sector, international and regional organisations and others


Goal 1. to reduce the humanitarian and socio-economic threats from landmines and ERW.

Goal 3. to reduce the threats to human security from disruptive challanges.




Strategic Goal 1 by countries in 2011






Strategic Goal 1 by purpose in 2011






Strategic Goal 2 by countries in 2011



A significant percentage of this stockpile resides in exposed and inappropriately equipped storage facilities, a situation which accelerates its deterioration.


Strategic Goal 3 by countries in 2011






Strategic Goal 3 by purpose in 2011
